**Special Note:** All tournament information (lake/ramp/times) are subject to change for extenuating circumstances. Any changes will be announced at the meeting prior to the tournament and/or on the Striper Kings Facebook Page. In case of inclement weather, a decision to cancel will be made on Thursday night before the tournament at 9PM and will be posted on the Striper Kings Facebook page. If cancelled, entry fees can be refunded or transferred to the next tournament.

**1. REGISTRATION:** Teams can register and pay entry fees at the meeting BEFORE the tournament or do a virtual registration by notifying the Tournament Director by 9:00PM the Thursday night before the day and night tournaments. All entry fees must be paid prior to the Check-in Times! The 2026 TWC Director is **Sammy Holt**.

**2. HOURS/TIMES:** All tournaments' hours/times are Lines-in, lines-out, Check-in/Weigh-In Closed as identified in the schedule. All teams must pick up their weigh-in slip (or be in line to pick up the slip) NLT 4:00 PM for the day tournaments, and 7:00AM for Night Tournaments to be eligible to weigh in fish. Although the weigh in may start prior to the 4:00PM check-in deadline, the scales cannot close until after 4:00 PM or 7:00AM (Night Tournaments) thus allowing all properly checked in teams to get to the scales. The weigh-in will end after the last boat that checked-in on time has weighed in, and after "Last-Call/Scales-are-Closed" is made by the tournament director. To be eligible to weigh-in fish, a Team must be Checked-In and have their Weigh-In Sheet. No fish accepted for weigh-in after the "Scales are Closed" call.

**3. ENTRY FEES:**

**A. Points Tournament:** (15 and younger fish free): Entry fee is \$30/person for Points Tournaments/Participation fee, and \$5/person Big Fish Entry. Participation fee portion is \$5 and covers \$1.25 to the General Fund to cover trophies, \$1.25 to the Middle-of-the-Road (MOTR) finish, and \$2.50 to the LVC Fund. Must be present at the time of the awards ceremony to win participation prizes.

**B. OPTIONAL Side Pots:** (Must be registered in the SK Points Tournament to enter side pots):

- B.1. \$30/Boat TWT Option with \$5 to the General Fund to pay for trophies and other tournament expenses and \$25 paid to the highest finishing boat in TWT.
- B.2. \$50/Boat TTT Option with \$5 to the SK General Fund to pay for trophies, \$5 set aside for an end of the year prize to the highest finishing Team in the TTT, and \$40 paid to the highest finishing boat in the TTT that day. All SK Tournaments have only one points system for all SK events. Any team in the Optional TTT will receive the exact same points that the team receives in the SK Points Tournament for that same day.

**4. Open Tournaments:** The Entry fees are \$60/boat includes \$10/boat 100% payout Big Fish Pot, \$40/boat payout (number of places paid depends on the number of boats (See SK points tournament rule 10.a), and \$10/boat going to the LVC Fund.

**5. LADIES RECOGNITION (Day/Tournament):** (Sponsored by the TWC) Ladies (age 18 and older) registered in a boat during the Ladies Recognition Day will compete for additional prizes including at least \$500 paid to the lady in the boat finishing the highest in the Open Tournament that day. Additional places/prizes for Ladies will depend on total sponsorship. The boat captain must have fished in at least 4 SK Points Tournaments to be eligible to sponsor a lady and fish separately in the Ladies Tournament.

**6. SPECIAL PRIZES/FEES:** Closest to the Weight Competition Drawing (Sponsored by TWC): All fish weighed in for a Point's Tournament after the team pays the \$100 Annual fee are eligible for the Special Cash Drawing. The fish weight (12, 14, or 16 pounds) will be drawn at the SK Christmas meeting. Ties will go to the highest ranked team in the point's race. Of the entry fees collected 50% will go to the LVC payout and the sponsorship 50% will be paid to the drawing winner.
